

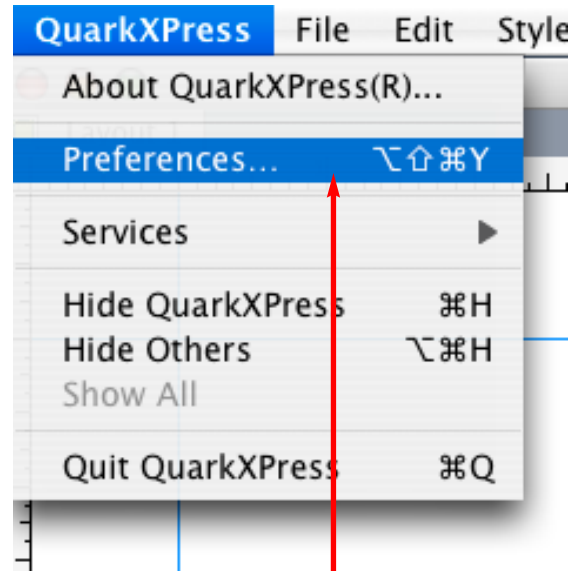


# QUARK PDF 8 SETTINGS

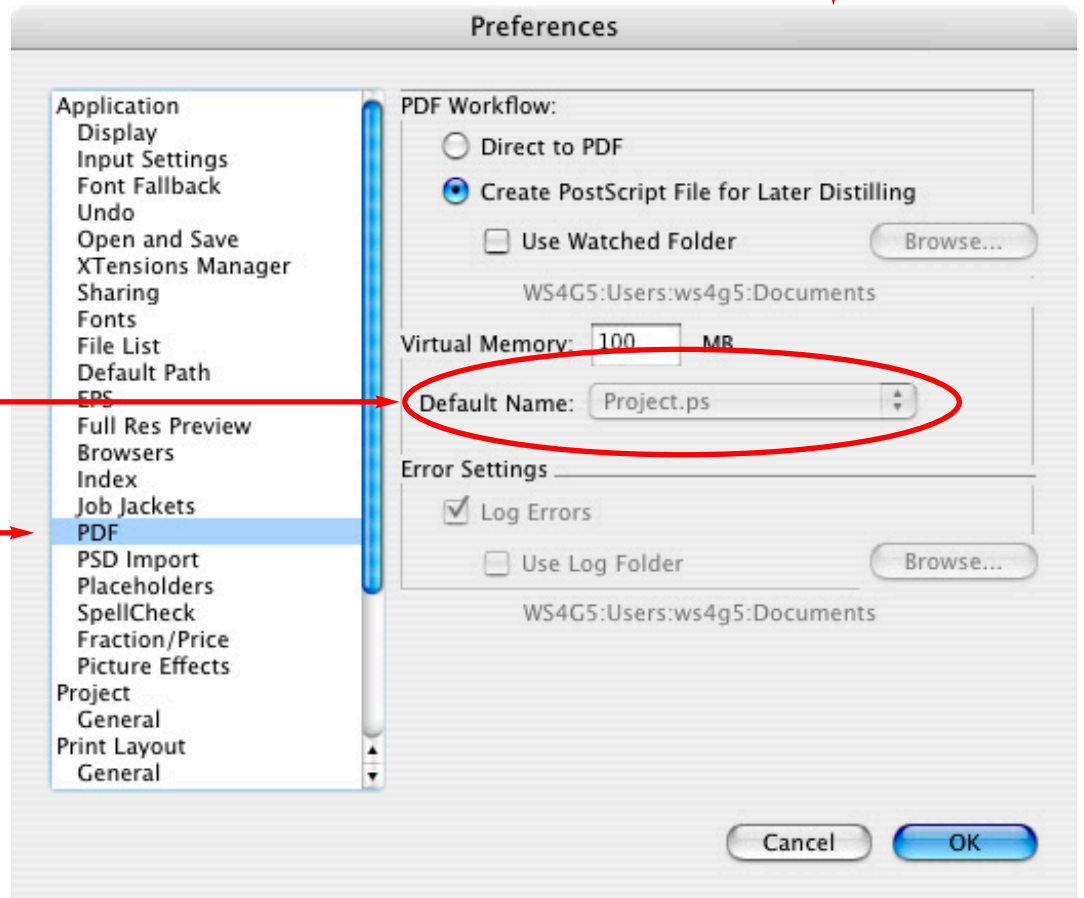
To create PDF's from Quark 8, set up predefined preferences using the following step:

1) Select **Preferences** under the QuarkXPress menu.



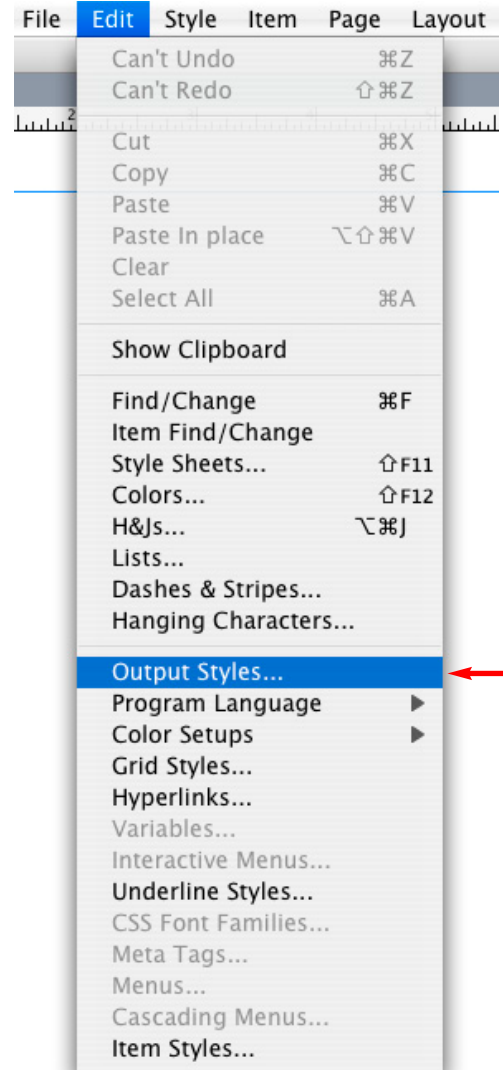
2) Select PDF from the list on the left side of the Preferences menu.

- Select **Create PostScript File for Later Distilling**
- **Default Name:** Set **Default Name** to **Project.ps**. This will automatically save your postscript file with name of your saved document.

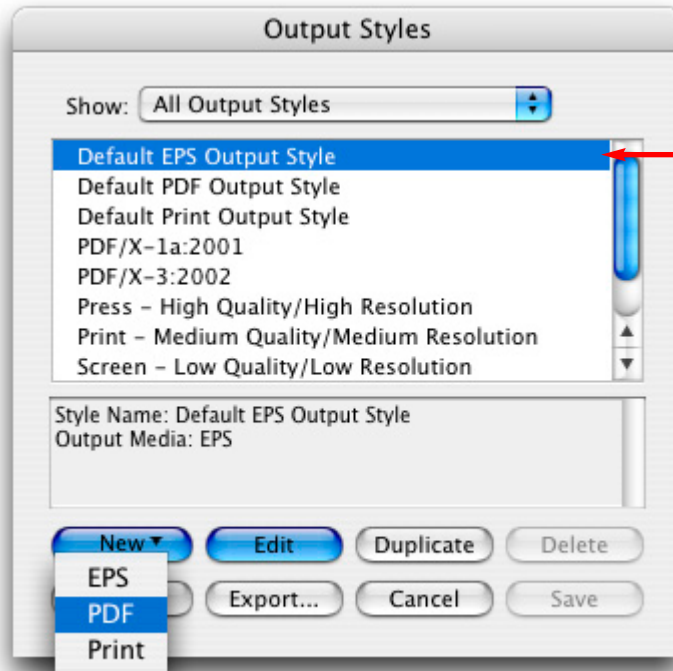


OUTPUT STYLE- Output Style will create a predefined set of instructions which assures that each set of PDF's sent to Hudson Printing will follow the specifications used in our workflow.

3) Under the **Edit** menu, select **Output Style**.

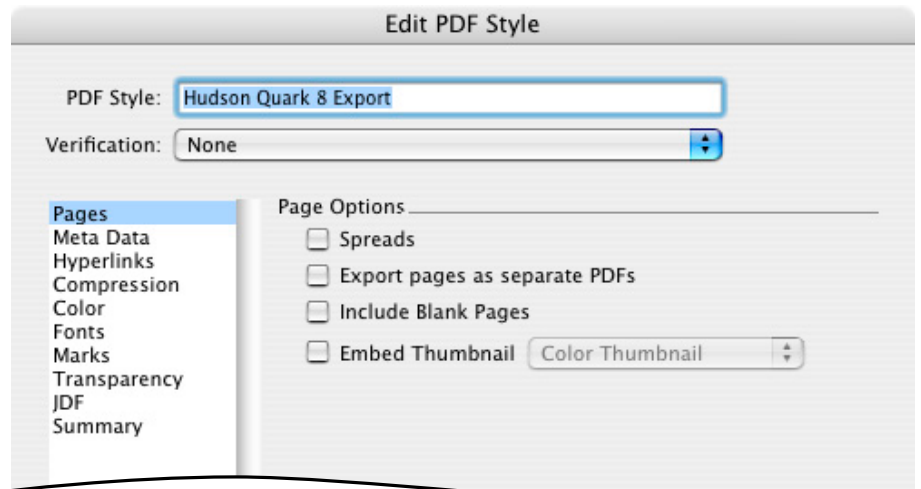


4) In the Output Style window, select **New** from the pull-down menu and select **PDF**.

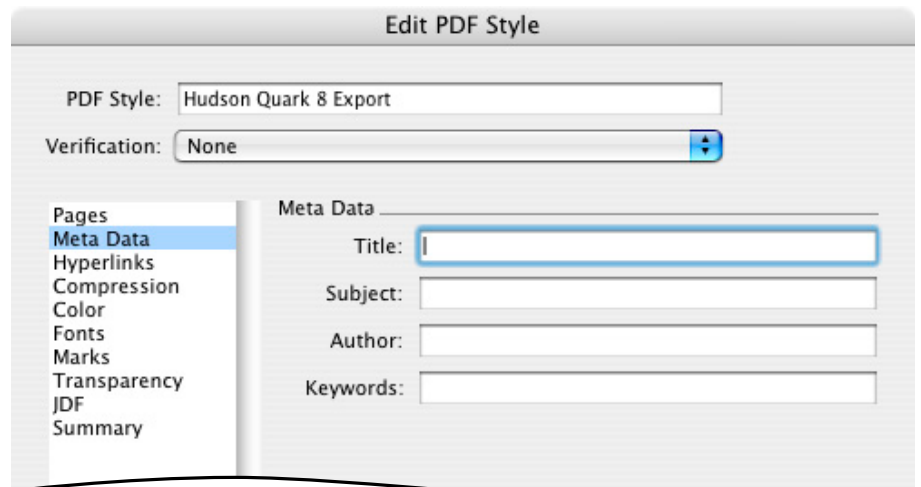


5) PDF Style

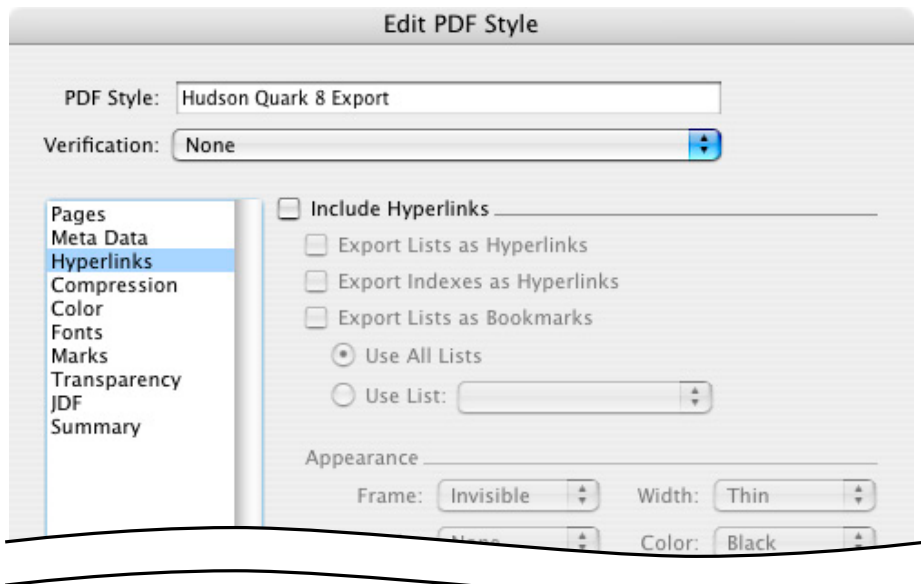
Name your settings *Hudson Quark 8 Export*.



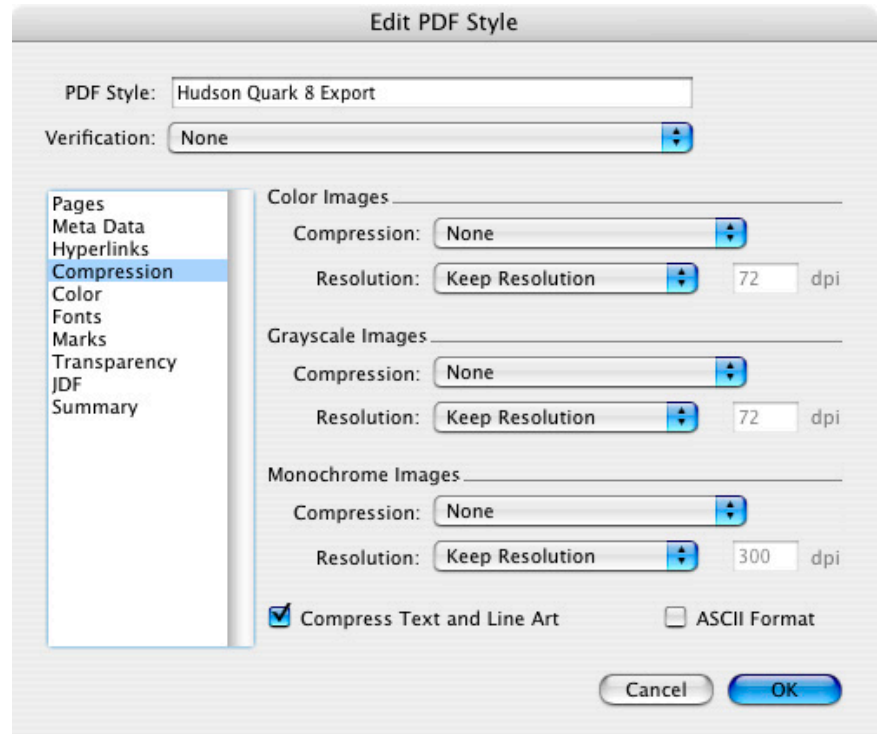
6) Set the **Meta Data** window as shown to the right. In the *Title* box of the Meta Data window, the name given to your layout will be displayed.



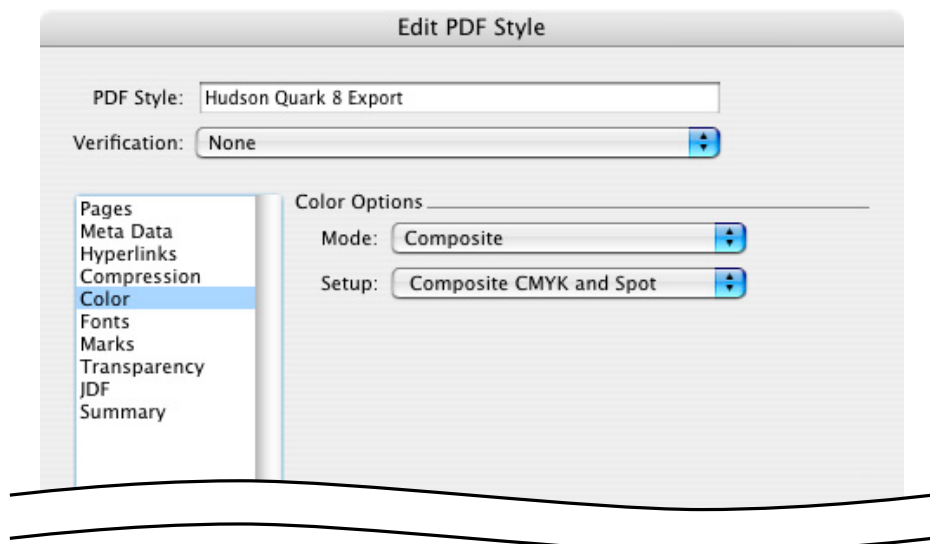
7) Set the **Hyperlinks** window as shown to the right.



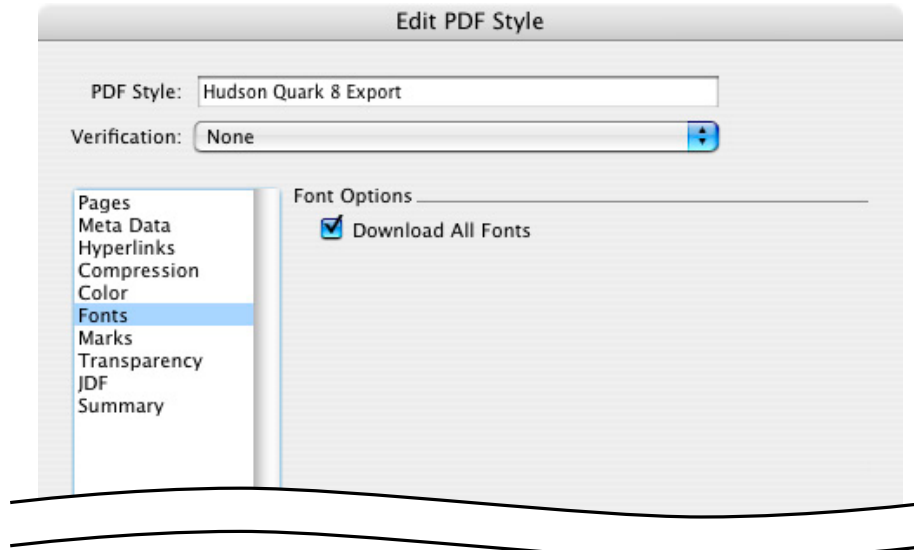
8) Set the **Compression** window as shown to the right.



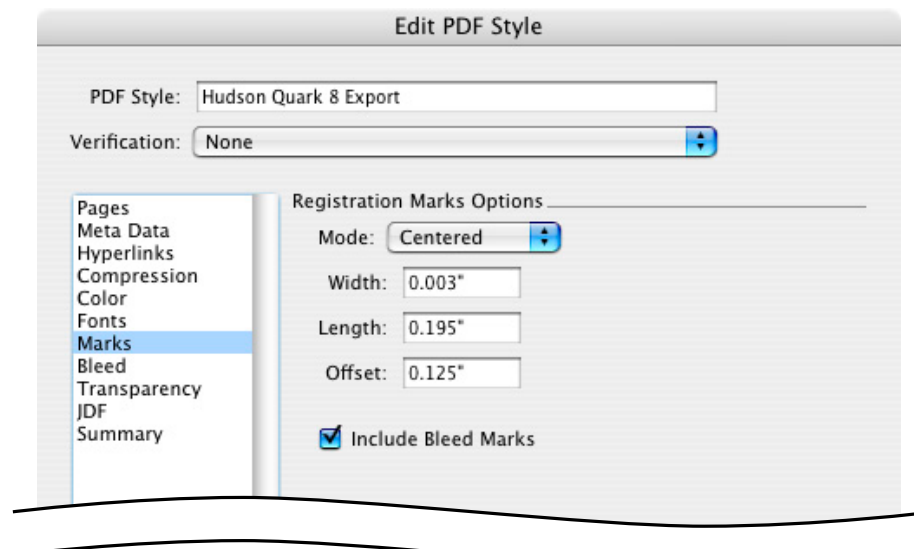
9) Set the **Color** window as shown to the right.



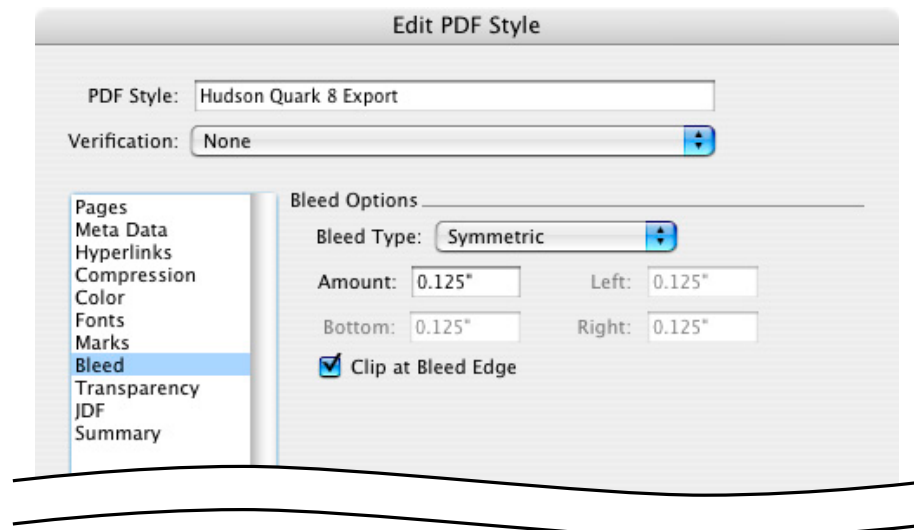
10) Set the **Fonts** window as shown to the right.



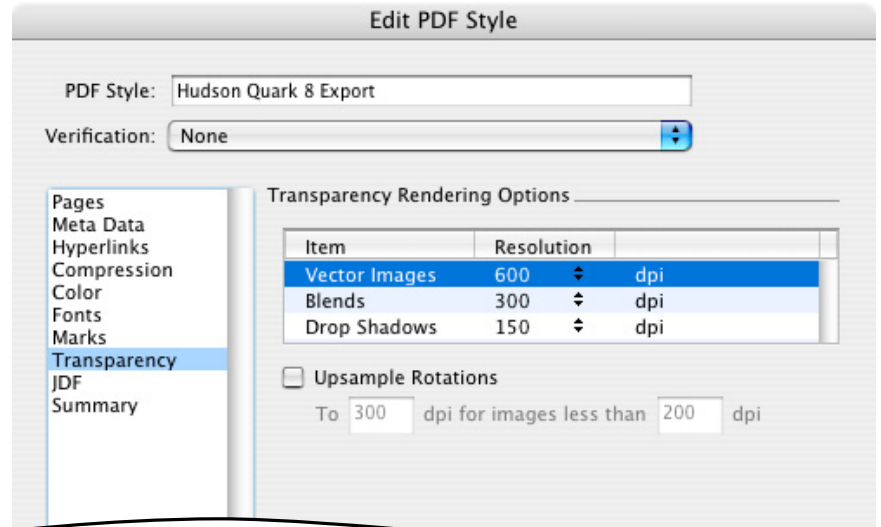
11) Set the **Marks** window as shown to the right.



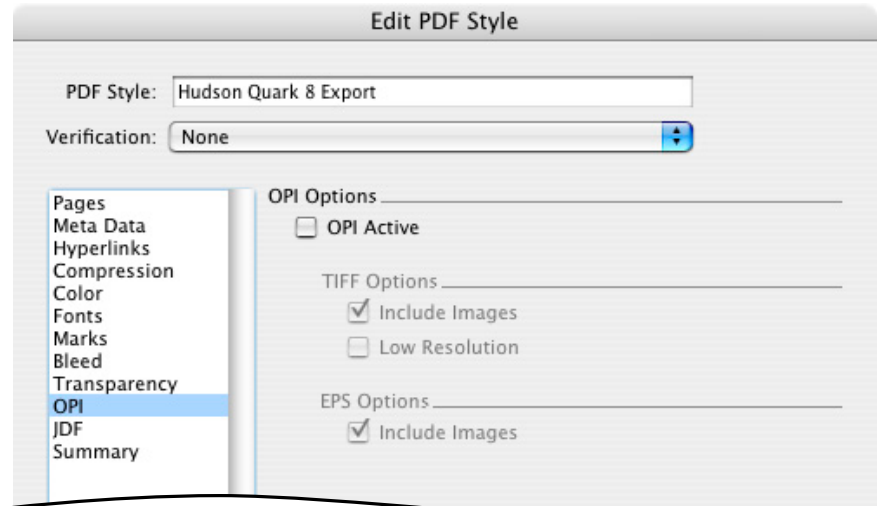
12) Set the **Bleed** window as shown to the right.



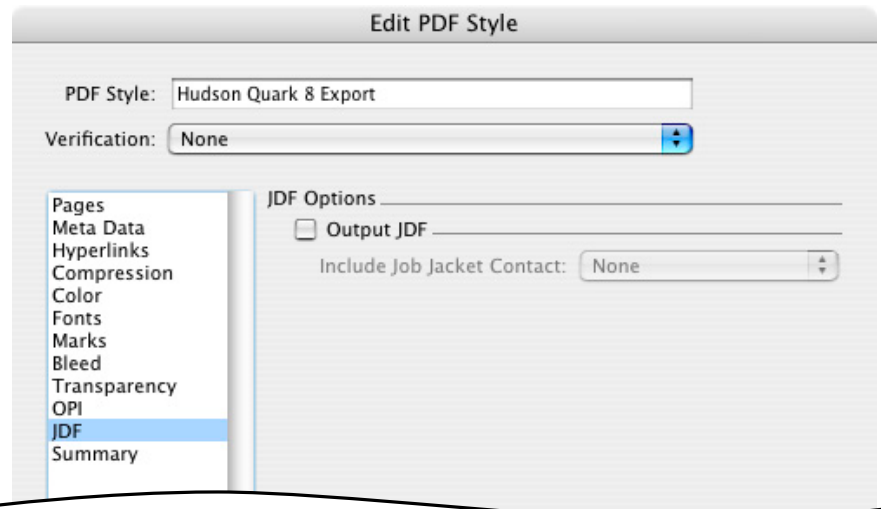
13) Set the **Transparency** window as shown to the right.



14) Set the **OPI** window as shown to the right



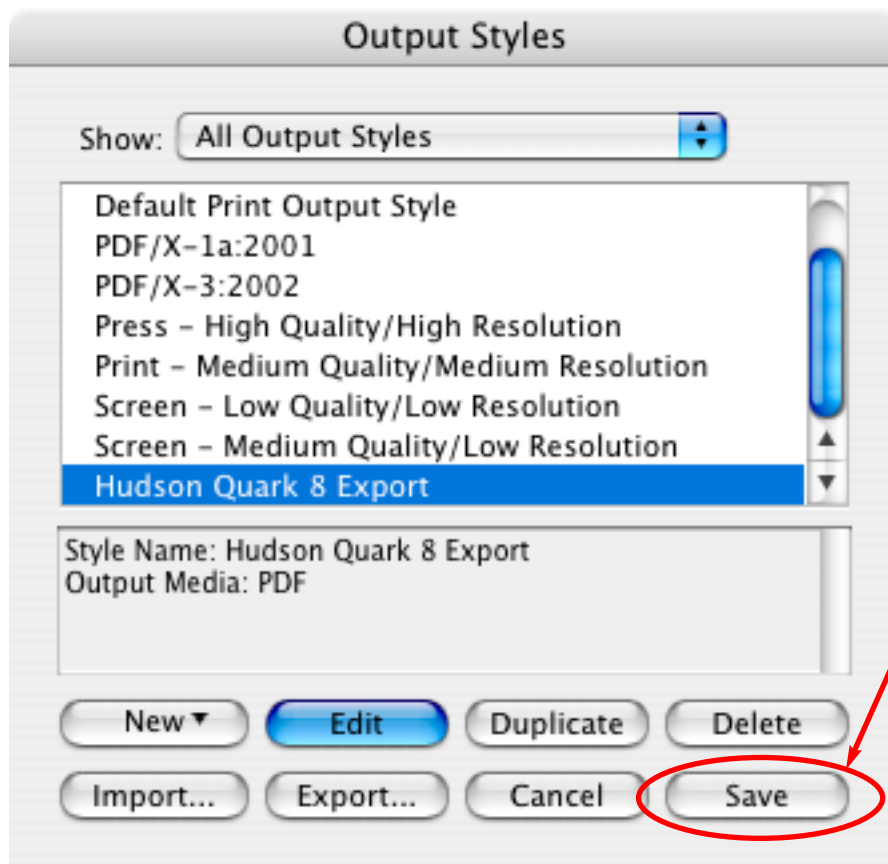
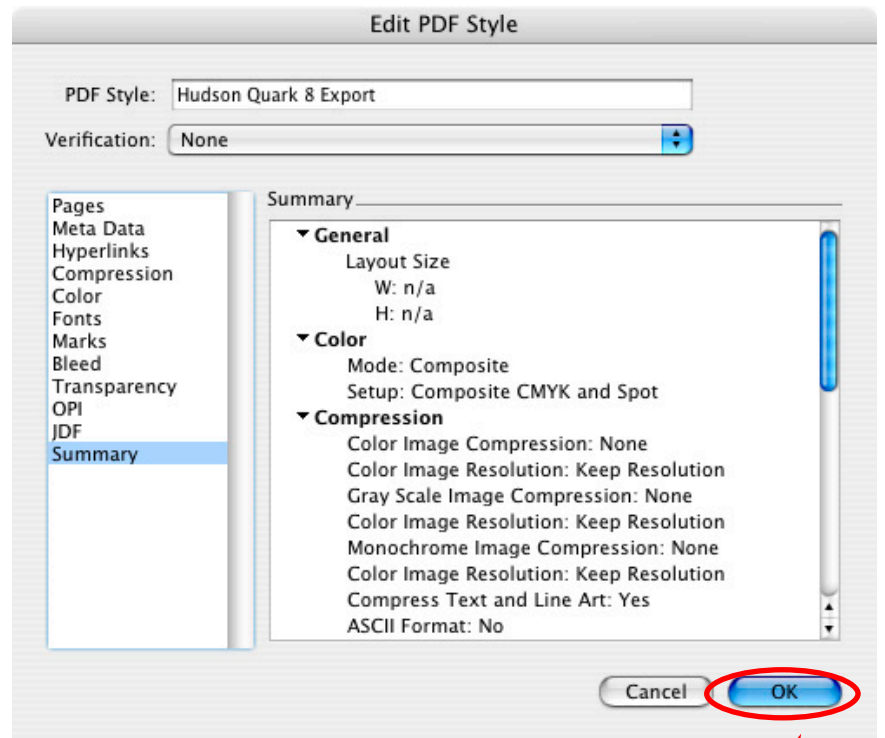
15) Set the **JDF** window as shown to the right



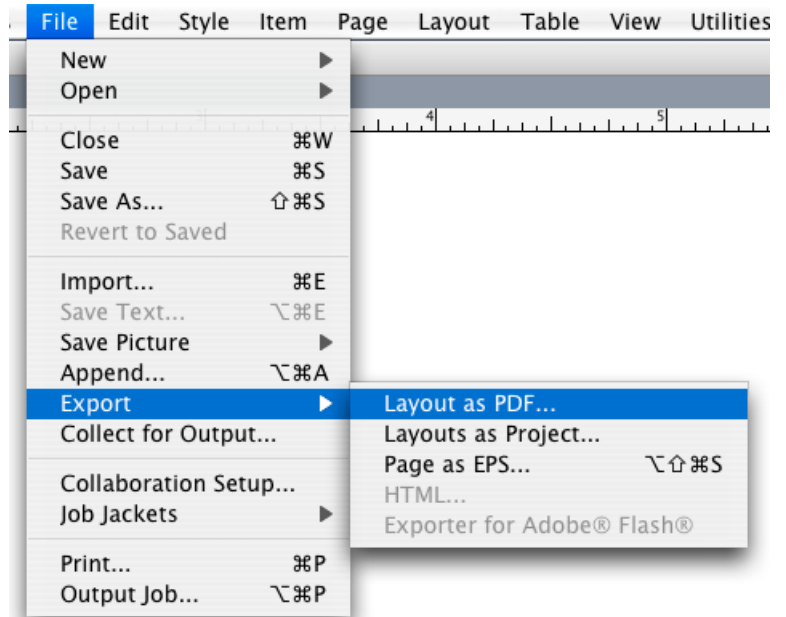
16) **Summary**

Once you have finished steps 1-15, the settings will appear in the **Summary** window.

Hit **OK** and you will be sent back to the Output Styles window, click save.



When you are ready to create PDF's, go to the File menu and select **Export > Layout as PDF**. The Export as PDF window will be displayed.



Save your PostScript file(s) to your desktop.

We recommend that you save your pages into 10 page increments and include the range in your document name. 1-10, 11-20 etc...

You may then drop the .ps files into Acrobat Distiller using Hudson's Distiller Settings for your particular version. We recommend *not* using hotfolders in Distiller but rather the Distiller window itself.

The setting of *Capture Settings* will be selected by default. Make sure that your "**Hudson**" PDF Style (steps 1-16) is selected.
